## Steel Bridge and Concrete Canoe Display

University displays are encouraged to bring a tent and sandbags to secure their tents on the concrete surface in front of the south entrance to the FAU Football stadium. Teams are asked to place their displays on the concrete walkway connecting the parking garage to the FAU Football Stadium. Steel bridge and concrete canoe drop-offs will be conducted in the delivery circle at the north end of the stadium, and items offloaded there will be transported underneath the stadium grandstand to the south side for display. Due to traffic safety, trailers are not allowed to stop on N. University Drive or FAU Boulevard for drop-off.
